



Get Ready for the Dog Days of Summer

Have you ever heard of the phrase "The Dog Days of Summer" and wondered where it came from? In my house you might think that the hottest days of summer are aptly named because it is during these times my dogs Sugar and Suzy Q slow down, lay around more and look just plain "dog tired".

It is a logical conclusion, but in reality this phrase dates back to Ancient Roman times when the dog days (diēs caniculārēs) was associated with the star Sirius. They considered Sirius to be the "Dog Star" because it is the brightest star in the constellation Canis Major (Large Dog). It was so bright that they determine that this star must also contribute to the extra heat felt in July and August.

On a more serious note, it was recently reported that dog bites accounted for more than one-third of all homeowners insurance liability claim dollars paid out in

2011, costing nearly \$479 million, according to the Insurance Information Institute (I.I.I).

If you are a dog owner be sure you know what is covered by your homeowners insurance. Some companies require dog owners to sign liability waivers for dog bites, or may put a coverage sub-limit associated with animals. I.l.l. advises homeowners to consider purchasing an umbrella liability policy that can protect you against these types of personal liabilities at coverages much higher than your typical homeowners' policy at very reasonable costs. To reduce the chances of a dog biting someone, consider taking the following steps:

- Consult with a professional (e.g., veterinarian, animal behaviorist, or responsible breeder) to learn about suitable breeds of dogs for your household and neighborhood.
- Spend time with a dog before buying or adopting it. Use caution when bringing a dog into a home with an infant or toddler.
 A dog with a history of aggression is inappropriate in a household with children.
- Have your dog spayed or neutered.
 Studies show that dogs are three times more likely to bite if they are NOT neutered.

- Socialize your dog so it knows how to act with other people and animals.
- Discourage children from disturbing a dog that is eating or sleeping.
- Play non-aggressive games with your dog, such as "go fetch." Playing aggressive games like "tug-of-war" can encourage inappropriate behavior.
- Avoid exposing your dog to new situations in which you are unsure of its response.
- Never approach a strange dog and always avoid eye contact with a dog that appears threatening.

In spite of all of this most dogs are friendly, loving, irreplaceable members of a family just like our dogs Sugar and Suzy Q. The most important thing you can do is be a responsible pet owner and provide proper training and limitations for "Man's Best Friend".

On the Record!

If you haven't experienced a disaster in your own home we all know of someone who has. Having adequate insurance is of course very important, but equally important is having an up-to date record or inventory of all the personal belongings that you have in your home. This list would ideally include a complete list of your personal property and include prices, model and serial numbers and copies of receipts. The first thing this list does is help you know what amount of insurance you need to buy. Also if you have this information ready it can almost guaranty a smoother recovery as well as improved negotiations with your insurance company.

In my experience very few people have created an inventory like this. No one wants to think that something could happen to them. One simple way is to take a video camera through your home and talk about the items in each room. Be sure to document designer and other high value items. You might even video tape the receipt. There are limits on all insurance policies so be sure to ask your agent if these high value items are covered on your policy. Then take that video and store it at a family member's or friend's house; a safe location other than your own home.

Need Help? Go to our website on the home insurance page and there is a link to an inventory worksheet to help you get started. Also the Insurance Information Institute has a Web-based inventory software that can be found at KnowYourStuff.org. Here you can set up your online account. The software will easily guide you through the process of creating and updating your home inventory. You can also upload photographs and scanned receipts or appraisal forms, and generate several types of reports once your inventory is complete, or if you need to file a claim. The software includes free, **secure online storage** so you can access your inventory anywhere, anytime—which can be important.

You can also download the new Know Your Stuff® - Home Inventory app in the iTunes App Store. Information entered either through the iPhone app or through the Webbased software will automatically synchronize between the two. All of your information will be kept in your personal, password protected account, on Amazon secure servers. Both versions are completely free of charge.

Most of these suggestions can apply to businesses as well. Don't be caught unprepared, get it all "On the Record"!
